23 Apr 1893 Michael **Cooney**, husband of Mary Cooney (nee Downs), aged 29 years. Native of Munmore, County Clare, Ireland. Funeral from his late residence No. 23_4 Wentworth avenue to All Saints Church, thence...to Calvary...

2 Aug At his residence 131 South Canal street, Timothy **Donlon**, born in 1835 in County Clare, Ireland...to Calvary [cemetery]. Albany [NY] papers...please copy. [Donnellans from Newmarket settled in Cohoes NY, a present-day suburb of Albany; their line is online via a descendant.]

23 Jun 1892 William **Egan**, brother of Patrick, Dennis and Officer James Egan, aged 25 years, native of County Clare, Ireland. Funeral from his residence No. 53 Henry street, near Canal, to the Jesuit Church...thence to Calvary cemetery.

21 Jan 1882 Martin **Higgins**, native of Ennis, County Clare, came to his death by accident at the Union Iron and Steel Rolling Mill...[Funeral] from his late residence 2706 to St. Bridget's Church...to Calvary [cemetery].

5 Aug 1879 John **McInerney**, aged 40, native of the Parish of Killureen, county Clare, Ireland...St. Patrick's Church to Calvary [cemetery].

21 Sep 1887 [date of publication] At his residence No 584 South Jefferson street, Michael, husband of Bridget **Ronan**, nee Crotty; a native of County Clare, Ireland, aged 43 years. Funeral...to Jesuit Church, thence to Calvary Cemetery. Buffalo and Albany (N.Y.) papers please copy.
