

# FOR CRIMES ACT VICTIMS.

At the Cork Winter Assizes of 1882, Michael Malley, of Tulla, county Clare, was put on trial charged with firing into a house. At the time the new Crimes Act was in beautiful working order, and special juries to convict on any evidence abounded. Mr. Malley had a special jury, and was of course convicted and sentenced to a long term of penal servitude, though it was proved at the trial that he cou'd not possibly have been at the scene of the shooting at the time it was alleged to have taken place, being then many miles distant. However (such a trifling circumstance did not deter the special jury from bringing in a verdict of guilty in the cause of law and order.

Mr. Malley has a young family who have been subjected to very great privation through the taking away of their breadwinner, and a subscription for their relief was inaugurated by a few Nationalists in their neighborhood.
